

Do you need a licence?



As of **September 2009**, if you want to use our songs you may need a licence.

Anna and Abi of Piccolomusic are now able to give you permission to use our large range of traditional and original songs for children written and arranged by us. We are the copyright holders and publishers. Please note we are still unable to give permission for you to play the small number of songs recorded by us but written by other artists.

If you are in an **Early Years Setting such as a school, nursery, or library and run music classes/sessions for visiting members of the public on your premises or elsewhere**, you will need a licence to play the eligible songs and CDs in your classes/sessions and to sing the songs live. The license does not allow copying of the CDs or any tracks on them.

If you are running up to 60 sessions in one year the licence is free. You will still need to register with us, but no fee will be incurred. If you are running more sessions than this a year, a nominal fee will be incurred starting at £5 per year.

If you are an **independent music group a music franchise or a freelance children's music leader**, you will need a licence to play the eligible songs and CDs, or sing the songs live or to add songs to a compilation CD for use in your classes/sessions. The compilation CDs can only be used by class leaders working in your business and are not for resale.

The licence fee depends on how many sessions you run. The minimum fee is £25 per year and this would allow you to run 2 sessions a week and up to 50 parties and/or untimetabled sessions a year.
